

Vice-Admiral Sanjay Jasjit Singh assumed the position of Vice-Chief of Naval Staff (VCNS) as part of a series of high-level changes in the Indian Navy.

New Vice-Chief of Navy -

>> On April 2nd, Vice-Admiral Sanjay Jasjit Singh assumed the position of Vice-Chief of Naval Staff (VCNS) as part of a series of high-level changes in the Indian Navy. Vice Admiral Singh graduated from the National Defence Academy in Pune and



joined the Indian Navy's executive branch in 1986. Over his 37-year career, he has served on various types of ships and held many leadership roles, including Assistant Chief of Naval Staff (CSNCO), Flag Officer Commanding of the Western Fleet, Commandant Naval War College, and Controller Personnel Services. Prior to his current position as VCNS, he was Deputy Chief of Integrated Defence Staff (Operations). In recognition of his distinguished service, he was awarded the Nao Sena Medal in 2009 and the AtiVishishtSeva Medal in 2020.

As part of the recent high-level changes in the Indian Navy, Vice-Admiral Suraj Berry has assumed the position of Chief of Personnel (COP), while Vice-Admiral Atul Anand has taken over as Director-General Naval Operations (DGNO). Vice-Admiral Anand joined the Executive Branch of the Navy in 1988 and served as the Flag Officer Commanding of the Maharashtra and Karnataka Naval Areas before being promoted to a three-star officer and assuming the role of DGNO. Vice-Admiral Berry, who specializes in gunnery and missile warfare, was commissioned in 1987 and had previously served as Controller-Personnel Services at naval headquarters before taking up his new role as COP.

Despite being re-elected as NRAI president in September 2021 for a four-year term, he had to go on a leave of absence as he had completed the maximum permissible tenure as the head of the federation.







Debadatta Chand has been appointed as the Managing Director (MD) of Bank of Baroda (BOB), according to a government announcement made on April 29. Chand is currently serving as the Executive Director of the bank. He will assume the position of MD for a term of three years, effective from July 1, 2023, or until further notice. This appointment follows the term extension of the previous MD, Sanjiv Chadha, which ended on January 19, 2021, and was extended by the government for an additional five months until June 30, 2021.



After receiving approval from the Appointments Committee of the Cabinet, led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the appointment notifications were issued. In January of this year, the Financial Services Institutions Bureau (FSIB), which is responsible for recruiting directors for state-owned banks and financial institutions, recommended Debadatta Chand's name for the position of Managing Director and CEO at Bank of Baroda.



C. R. Rao wins International Prize in Statistics 2023

The 2023 International Prize in Statistics, which is regarded as the equivalent of the Nobel Prize in statistics, has been awarded to Calyampudi Radhakrishna Rao, an Indian-American statistician.

International Prize in Statistics 2023 -

The 2023 International Prize in Statistics, which is regarded as the equivalent of the Nobel Prize in statistics, has been awarded to Calyampudi Radhakrishna Rao, an Indian-American statistician. The prize, established in 2016, is presented once



every two years to an individual or team that has made significant contributions to science, technology, and human welfare through the use of statistics. The award is given out by a collaboration of five major international statistics organizations and recognizes major accomplishments by an individual or team. Rao will be honored with the prize, which carries an \$80,000 cash award, at the International Statistical Institute World Statistics Congress in Ottawa, Canada, in July.





What was Rao's 1945 paper about?

Rao's groundbreaking paper, 'Information and accuracy attainable in the estimation of statistical parameters', was published in 1945 in the Bulletin of the Calcutta Mathematical Society, a journal that is otherwise not well known to the statistics community. The paper was subsequently included in the book Breakthroughs in Statistics, 1890-1990. This was an impressive achievement given Rao was only 25 at the time and had just completed his master's degree in statistics two years prior.

About the C. R. Rao -

- Calyampudi Radhakrishna Rao, born in Karnataka in 1920, is an Emeritus Eberly professor in the statistics department at Pennsylvania State University. He played a significant role in establishing the Indian Statistical Institute in Kolkata and has been associated with the institute since 1941. Rao holds PhD and ScD degrees from Cambridge University.
- In addition to being awarded the Padma Bhusan in 1968 and the Padma Vibhushan in 2001, Rao was the recipient of the SS Bhatnagar Prize in 1963 and was elected a fellow of the Royal Society in 1967. He also received the Wilks Medal of the American Statistical Association in 1979 and the US National Medal of Science in 2002.

Abraham has received funding from the US Department of Defense for urinary diagnostic markers of interstitial cystitis, and is also a co-author of the AUA White Paper on Rationale and Strategies for Reducing Urologic Post-Operative Opioid Prescribing.

Angela Merkel receives Germany's highest honor

- ▶ Former Chancellor Angela Merkel received Germany's highest Order of Merit. The Grand Cross award was handed to her by President Frank-Walter Steinmeier. The award has only been given twice before, to former chancellors Konrad Adenauer and Helmut Kohl. All three former leaders belong to the conservative Christian Democratic Union (CDU).
- The Order of Merit entails no financial reward. Merkel led Germany from 2005 to 2021, totaling four terms in office. She did not seek a fifth term. She was the first woman to take the post of chancellor



and the first German head of government to have grown up in socialist East Germany. Steinmeier praised Merkel as an "unprecedented politician" who successfully steered Germany through difficult times, including the 2008 financial meltdown and the 2015 refugee crisis. Merkel, 68, was the first woman to lead Germany and the first chancellor who grew up behind the Iron Curtain in communist East Germany.

About the Order of Merit -

Germany's highest Order of Merit is known as the Federal Cross of Merit, or Bundesverdienstkreuz in German. It is awarded by the President of Germany to individuals who have made significant contributions to the nation's cultural, economic, or political life, or have provided outstanding service to society. The Order of Merit was established in 1951, and is considered to be one of the most prestigious awards in Germany. There are eight classes of the Order of Merit, with the highest being the Grand Cross, followed by the First Class Cross, Second Class Cross, and so on. The award is not restricted to German citizens and is frequently bestowed upon foreigners who have contributed to Germany's social, political, or cultural development.



SBI to launch new current accounts and savings accounts in FY24 to attract deposits

- The SBI has revealed plans to introduce new variants of current accounts and savings accounts in the fiscal year 2023-24, as it seeks to reduce the gap between deposit growth and credit growth.
- The State Bank of India (SBI) has revealed plans to introduce new variants of current accounts and savings accounts in the fiscal year 2023-24, as it seeks to reduce the gap between deposit growth and credit growth. The bank intends to launch two new variants of current accounts, one with a balance of 150,000 and another with a balance of 150 lakh.



It also plans to introduce a new savings account called "Parivar" (family) account.

- The move comes as SBI aims to increase its customer base and attract more deposits, particularly from retail customers. The bank has identified the need to offer more attractive products and services in order to achieve this goal. By introducing new variants of current accounts and savings accounts, SBI hopes to provide greater flexibility and convenience to its customers, and to increase its market share in the Indian banking sector.
- SBI's deposit growth has lagged behind its credit growth in recent quarters. By the end of 2022, the bank's domestic deposits had grown by 8.86% year-on-year, while domestic advances had grown by 16.91% year-on-year. The new plans are designed to help the bank boost its deposit growth and reduce the gap between deposits and advances.
- SBI expects its domestic deposits and domestic advances to grow by around 12% and 16% year-on-year, respectively, in the fiscal year 2023-24. The bank also plans to enhance its digital banking platform to provide a more seamless and user-friendly experience for its customers....

PM Jan Dhan Yojana sees record 50,000 crore surge in balance

- Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana sees a surge in account balances and new account holders.
- The Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) scheme has achieved a significant milestone in the financial year ending March 31, 2023. The basic bank accounts under the scheme have registered a record surge of 150,000 crores, with the total balance reaching 11.99 lakh crore, an increase from ¹ 1.49-lakh crore in the previous financial year. Additionally, there has been





an addition of 5 crore new accounts under the scheme, bringing the total number of beneficiaries to 48.65 crores.

Public sector banks lead as key drivers of the PM.JDY scheme -

According to a senior SBI official, the significant increase in the total balance on a year-on-year basis indicates the growing use of these accounts for various purposes by both the government and beneficiaries. The public sector banks are the key



drivers of the scheme, holding 1.55-lakh crore with them as deposits, followed by Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) with ¹ 38,832 crores. Private sector banks hold the remaining deposits.

The growth of the Jan Dhan scheme over the last five years has been significant, with almost a quarter of the present total balance coming in the year 2022-23. This development is believed to be driven by a healthy rural economy, which gained traction in the last financial year, according to a senior analyst with a private rating agency.

Jan Dhan scheme's inbuilt insurance cover offers 1 lakh accident cover -

▶ Under the Jan Dhan scheme, the RuPay card comes with an inbuilt accident insurance cover of 1 lakh, valid for up to 90 days after the cardholder carries out a successful transaction at a merchant establishment, ATM, or e-commerce platform. However, the pace of issuing RuPay cards appears to have slowed down, with only 33 crore cards issued so far out of about 49 crore account holders. Additionally, about 8 percent of PMJDY accounts have zero balances, while the average balance is over 12,400, according to RBI data....

RBI to launch centralised portal PRAVAAH for licencing, approval applications

- RBI is set to introduce a new secured web-based portal called "PRAVAAH", aimed at simplifying and streamlining the application processes.
- RBI is set to introduce a new secured web-based portal called "PRAVAAH" (Platform for Regulatory Application, Validation And AutHorisation) aimed at simplifying and streamlining the application processes. The portal will display the timeframes for deciding on applications and approvals, leading to greater effectiveness in regulatory processes and



making it easier for regulated entities to do business with RBI.

Key Features of PRAVAAH portal:

It will provide transparent timelines for the decision-making process on the applications/approvals sought by the applicants.





- This will enable the applicants to know the expected timeframes for the decision on their applications, and they can plan their business activities accordingly.
- Additionally, PRAVAAH will offer a single interface for applicants to submit and track the status of their applications, making it easier to monitor the application's progress.
- Moreover, it will enable RBI to standardize the application forms, making the application process more uniform and simpler.

RBI Foundation Day 2023 observed on 1st April

India becomes first country to develop model for TB estimation.

India has developed a country-level mathematical model that estimates the prevalence of tuberculosis (TB) cases in the country. The model allows for TB incidence and mortality estimate data to be available by March each year, months before the World Health Organization (WHO) releases its annual estimates in October. The model, which draws from data such as an individual's infection and disease status, healthcare utilization, and treatment outcomes, was presented at the 36th Stop TB Partnership Board meeting in Varanasi. The Indian model estimated the



TB incidence rate in India to be 196 in 2022, lower than the WHO's estimate of 210 and suggested 3.20 lakh TB mortality absolute numbers in 2022, lower than WHO's estimated 4.94 lakhs.

India's Efforts to Eliminate TB: Improved Treatment and Patient Tracking -

India has made significant efforts to increase the National TB Elimination Program coverage and generate more evidence. Laboratory services have been scaled up and decentralized with highquality rapid diagnostic tests. In addition, India has introduced a daily regimen for first-line treatment of tuberculosis, integrating the regimens in the public and private sectors to ensure universal access to TB care. Patients with drug-resistant TB have been provided with injection-free, shorter, and better second-line treatment. The use of Nikshay, a tracking system for patients, has helped to improve the treatment outcomes of all types of patients in both the public and private sectors, including those who may have otherwise been lost to follow-up.









India become world's second-largest solar manufacturer by 2026

India has been making significant strides toward renewable energy in recent years, with a focus on solar energy. The country has set ambitious targets to increase its solar energy capacity and has been taking various steps to achieve them. In line with this, India is expected to become the world's secondlargest solar manufacturer by 2026.



What is NATO and its History?

- The founding members of NATO were the United States, Canada, and ten European nations including Belgium, Denmark, France, Iceland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, and the United Kingdom. Since then, the alliance has expanded to include 31 member countries.
- The organization operates on the principle of collective defense, with members agreeing to mutual defense in response to an attack by an external party. NATO also engages in crisis management, conflict prevention, and peacekeeping operations around the world.

To become a member of NATO, a country must meet the following criteria:

- Political and economic stability: The country must have a stable democratic government, a functioning market economy, and a proven record of respecting human rights and the rule of law.
- Military readiness: The country must have a capable and well-trained military that can contribute to the collective defense of the alliance. This includes a commitment to investing in defense and maintaining modern equipment.





- Commitment to collective defense: The country must be willing and able to contribute to the collective defense of the alliance, including by supporting other member countries in times of need.
- Compatibility with NATO values: The country must share the values of the alliance, including * a commitment to democracy, individual liberty, and the rule of law.
- Geographic proximity: While not an official requirement, NATO tends to give preference to countries that are in close geographic proximity to existing members, as this makes it easier to coordinate and deploy forces in times of crisis.

'MF Hydra': World's first liquid hydrogenpowered ferry gets operational

Norwegian company Norled has successfully launched the world's first ferry that runs on liquid hydrogen. The vessel, called MF Hydra, is a hybrid that uses both batteries and liquid hydrogen fuel cell

Norwegian company Norled has successfully launched the world's first ferry that runs on liquid hydrogen. The vessel, called MF Hydra, is a hybrid that uses both batteries and liquid hydrogen fuel cells. It underwent sea trials for two weeks after initial



testing at Hjelmeland quay earlier this year. The Norwegian Maritime Authority (NMA) has given final approval for the ferry to operate. This milestone achievement is a significant step towards reducing greenhouse gas emissions in the maritime industry, as hydrogen fuel cells produce only clean water as a byproduct.

Dimension of the MF Hydra ferry:

The ferry, MF Hydra, has received clearance from the Norwegian Maritime Administration to start sailing. The vessel, delivered in 2021, has a length of 82.4 meters and can carry up to 300 passengers and 80 vehicles. With its two 200 kW fuel cells, two 440 kW generators, and two Shottel thrusters, it can travel at a speed of 9 knots. The hydrogen systems for the ferry were provided by Linde Engineering in Germany, while the fuel cells that generate electricity from hydrogen were developed by Danish company Ballard. The vessel was equipped and completed by Westcon in Ølensvåg, in collaboration with system integrator SEAM from Karmøy, which also supplied the automation scope for the hydrogen system. Corvus Energy supplied the batteries for the vessel.

Saudi Arabia becomes Shanghai Cooperation Organization dialogue partner

The Saudi Arabian government has taken a significant step towards joining the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO), a regional alliance dominated by China and Russia. During a cabinet meeting presided over by King Salman bin Abdulaziz, a memorandum was approved to initiate dialogue with the SCO. The decision to pursue membership was reportedly raised during a visit to Saudi Arabia by Chinese President Xi Jinping in December of last year.



According to sources, the decision to pursue dialogue partner status with the Shanghai Cooperation Organization is seen as the first step towards eventual full membership for Saudi Arabia. This decision was made after Saudi Aramco's announcement of increased investment in China, including a joint venture in northeast China and acquiring a stake in a privately owned petrochemical group. The growing relationship between Riyadh and Beijing has caused concern in Washington, which sees Chinese influence as a threat to U.S. interests. However, Saudi Arabia and other Gulf states have expressed worries about the United States' perceived disengagement from the region and are seeking to expand their partnerships. The U.S. has stated its intention to remain an active player in the Middle East despite these concerns.

About the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO)

The Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) was established in June 2001 by China, Russia, and several Central Asian countries including Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, and Tajikistan. It is an alliance that focuses on politics, economics, and security in the Eurasian region and is currently the largest regional organization in the world. The SCO consists of eight full members, four observer states, and several dialogue partners, including Turkey. In 2017, Pakistan and India were granted full membership. Iran, an SCO observer state since June 2005, was granted permanent membership in September 2021, and a year later, signed a memorandum of commitment to formally join as a full member.

Chinese Company Space Pioneer Successfully Launches Tianlong-2 Rocket into Orbit

Chinese company Space Pioneer has achieved a historic milestone in space exploration, launching its Tianlong-2 rocket into orbit from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Center in Inner Mongolia on April 2. This marks the first time a liquid-fueled rocket has been launched into orbit by a Chinese aerospace firm, and the first time a startup has successfully reached orbit on its initial attempt.





The Tianlong-2 rocket, also known as "Sky Dragon-2," has enabled Beijing Tianbing Technology to launch a small satellite named "Love Space Science" to a polar orbit around Earth. The satellite will test its remote sensing capabilities from this sunsynchronous orbit.

Tianlong-2 Rocket: Capable of Carrying 2 Tons to Low Earth Orbit -

The three-stage Tianlong-2 rocket is capable of carrying 2,000 kilograms (2 tons) to low Earth orbit



or 1,500 kg (1,5 tons) to a 500-kilometer-altitude sun-synchronous orbit. The rocket is fueled by coal-based kerosene, making use of three YF-102 gas generator engines that deliver a thrust of 193 tons at take-off. The Beijing Tianbing Technology Co. has stated that the rocket adopts a "three flat and one vertical" test and launch mode, enabling liquid rocket launch from a simple cement field. This innovation provides a solid foundation for large-scale launches.

China's Commercial Space Sector: Over 20 Private Rockets to Launch This Year -

In 2014, President Xi instructed China's air force to accelerate the integration of air and space capabilities, marking the country's commitment to the space race. This led to the birth of China's commercial space sector, with over 20 private and commercial rockets expected to be launched from China this year. Beijing Tianbing Technology Co. plans to improve its reusable large liquid carrier rockets, heavy liquid carrier rockets, and manned space shuttles. The company aims to use advanced aerospace propulsion technology and service solutions to enable orbital transportation and intercontinental transportation, and to help China's commercial rockets enter the era of big payloads and green aerospace. This will allow aerospace technology to benefit people's livelihoods and the lives of ordinary people....

- A panel in Japan's health ministry has approved the country's first abortion pill, in a major step for reproductive rights decades after other countries made abortion medication widely available.

The ministry's pharmaceutical board granted approval to the MeFeego Pack, an abortion pill manufactured by British pharmaceutical Linepharma, according to



a spokesperson from the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare.

Overview of the news -

- The medication consists of two types of pill, and can be used within nine weeks of pregnancy, according to Japanese public broadcaster NHK. In a clinical trial in Japan, 93% of participants had a complete abortion within 24 hours. The medication combines mifepristone and misoprostol, which the World Health Organization has included in its Essential Medicines List, described as safe and effective for pregnant people.
- It would provide an alternative to a surgical procedure amid calls for progress in women's reproductive rights and gender equality. In Japan, abortions have been usually performed with metal instruments. As this procedure is invasive, medical experts and others are calling for introduction of abortion pills in Japan.
- Under Japan's existing laws, women can only receive an abortion if a pregnancy "may significantly damage the person's physical health due to bodily or economic reasons" or if they became pregnant due to rape....



Syria becomes world's largest 'narco-state': Report

According to reports, Syria has now become the world's largest narco-state, with the majority of its foreign currency earnings coming from the production and export of Captagon, a highly addictive amphetamine commonly referred to as "poor man's coke". In line with the definition



- provided by Collins Dictionary, Syria can be classified as a narco-state as the illegal trade of narcotics, specifically Captagon, forms a significant portion of its economy, accounting for over 90 percent of the country's foreign currency earnings.
- Experts have indicated that Syria is the leading producer of Captagon, a highly addictive amphetamine that is primarily exported to the Gulf region. Due to sanctions or a halt in trading with Syria following the crackdown on protesters by President Bashar al-Assad in 2011, the regime, in conjunction



with Lebanon's Hezbollah, increased the production and export of Captagon to Gulf countries.

The rapid growth in the production and use of illicit drugs, particularly Captagon, has raised concerns globally. In response, the US enacted the Captagon Act last year, which links the trade of the drug to the Assad regime in Syria and labels it a "transnational security threat."

What is Captagon?

- >> Captagon is a popular recreational drug among the youth in Gulf states, as well as being used by armed individuals who feel invincible while under its influence
- It is sometimes referred to as "Captain Courage" or "Jihadi magic potion"
- Additionally, Captagon is used by dieters, students studying for exams, and people who work double shifts, at night, or have multiple jobs to make ends meet
- The cost of manufacturing Captagon is as low as USD 1 per pill
- However, the need to pay bribes to smugglers, soldiers, secret police, warlords, and customs officials to pass various routes and checkpoints increases the price of the drug
- The price can go up to USD 14-20 per pill due to these additional costs....

Ghana becomes first country to approve Oxford malaria vaccine for children

- ▶ Ghana has made history by becoming the first country to approve a highly effective malaria vaccine developed by scientists at the University of Oxford in the UK. The vaccine, called R21/Matrix-M, has exceeded the World Health Organization's target of 75% efficacy, making it a significant milestone in the fight against malaria.
- According to the World Health Organization (WHO), an estimated 619,000 people died from malaria in 2021, with the vast majority of the deaths being children in sub-Saharan Africa.
- MALARIA VACCINE

In Ghana, where malaria is endemic and perennial, an estimated 5.3 million cases and 12,500









deaths were recorded in 2021. The R21/Matrix-M vaccine, which has shown promising results in clinical trials, could be a game-changer in reducing the burden of malaria in Ghana and other sub-Saharan African countries.

Significance of this development:

- However, the WHO has yet to recommend the R21 vaccine for widespread use, and until it does, there is a question mark over the amount of international funding available for it. The vaccine's phase 3 trial is ongoing, but earlier trials have shown efficacy levels of 77%, a level that was maintained after a single booster dose given a year later.
- In contrast, the RTS,S vaccine, which the WHO recommended for use in a landmark move in 2021, has more modest efficacy levels. The approval of the R21/Matrix-M vaccine in Ghana is an important step in the fight against malaria, but its impact will depend on its approval and implementation in other sub-Saharan African countries.
- The Serum Institute of India, the biotechnology giant that is manufacturing the R21 vaccine, has the potential to manufacture more than 200 million doses annually. This offers hope that the vaccine could be made widely available in sub-Saharan Africa, where it is needed the most....

Nepal becomes founding member of **International Big Cats Alliance**

- Nepal has become a founding member of the International Big Cats Alliance. During the launch of the alliance under India's initiative, Minister for Energy Shakti Bahadur Basnet handed over the letter.

Zimbabwe to introduce gold-backed digital currency

To combat the falling value of the Zimbabwean currency, the Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe (RBZ) has announced plans to introduce a gold-backed digital currency. The digital gold tokens will be a form of electronic money, backed by gold held at the RBZ. This will enable holders of small amounts of Zimbabwean dollars to exchange their money for tokens and protect themselves against exchange rate fluctuations.



- The Zimbabwean economy operates on a dual currency structure, with the Zimbabwean dollar and the U.S. dollar in use. The U.S. dollar currently dominates and accounts for about 70% of domestic transactions, according to the RBZ. In an effort to halt the collapse of the Zimbabwean dollar and reduce the demand for the U.S. dollar, the RBZ introduced gold coins in July 2022.
- The RBZ had re-introduced the Zimbabwean dollar in 2019, replacing the previous multiple currency system that had been in place since 2009, when the country abandoned its old local dollar due to years of hyperinflation.
- Due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, the Zimbabwean government permitted individuals with free funds to use their foreign currency to make domestic payments for goods and services. This policy led to the current dual currency system, where the Zimbabwean dollar and the U.S. dollar are both in use for domestic transactions.

WTO rules India violated global trade rules in IT dispute

The World Trade Organization (WTO) has found that India has breached global trading regulations in a dispute over import duties on IT products with the European Union (EU), Japan, and Taiwan. The WTO panel's report recommended that India should modify the measures to conform with its obligations. The dispute began in 2019 when the EU objected to India's introduction of import duties of between 7.5% and 20% on various IT products, including mobile phones, integrated circuits, and components, stating that the tariffs exceeded the maximum rate.



Japan and Taiwan also lodged similar complaints that year.

EU says up to 600 million euros of exports affected by India's tariffs

- The EU is India's third-largest trading partner, and its exports worth up to 600 million euros (\$654.66 million) are directly affected by India's tariffs on an annual basis, according to Brussels. India's diplomatic mission in Geneva has not commented on whether it will appeal against the decision. However, if it does, the case will remain in legal limbo as the WTO's top appeals court is currently not functioning due to the United States opposition to judge appointments.
- The WTO panel found that India had already brought some of the tariffs under scrutiny in line with global trading regulations since 2020. While the panel supported the complaints against India,






it dismissed one of Japan's claims that India's customs notification lacked "predictability". The EU's trade department reiterated that a rules-based trading system was necessary for good trade relations, calling the tariffs "illegal" in a tweet.



He achieved this feat by pulling a short ball from Trent Boult behind square for four. Warner completed his half-century off 44 balls with a four off Ravichandran Ashwin. This was Warner's 57th fifty in the IPL, and he has also scored four centuries in the tournament. Additionally, he also became the highest run-scorer of the season during this innings

FIFA Rankings: India's Football Team Rises to 101

- According to the latest FIFA rankings, the Indian men's football team has climbed up five spots and is now ranked at 101.

The team earned 8.57 rating points after winning two matches against Myanmar and Kyrgyzstan in the Tri-nation tournament held last month in Imphal. However, India is still at the 19th position among 46 Asian nations with a total of 1200.66 points. India's highest-ever ranking was at the 94th position in 1996, and the team has rarely made it to the top-100, making this achievement noteworthy.

- In addition to MS Dhoni, Yuvraj Singh, the former Indian cricketer, was also awarded an honorary life membership of the Marylebone Cricket Club (MCC). Mithali Raj remains the top run-scorer in women's ODIs with 7805 runs in 232 games, while Jhulan Goswami is the leading wickettaker in the format with 255 scalps. The MCC is known for recognizing the contributions of exceptional cricketers to the sport, and this recognition is a testament to the achievements of these Indian cricketers....

An Armageddon game is a variant of blitz chess to determine a winner after a series of a drawn games. A drawn game in Armageddon is counted as a win for Black.









Russian superstar Daniil Medvedev Wins **Maiden Miami Opens Title 2023**

Russian tennis star Daniil Medvedev claimed his fourth title of the year by defeating Jannik Sinner in a closely-contested final match in Miami Opens 2023. Medvedev, who was once the top-ranked player in the world, has now won 24 out of his last 25 matches, including his latest victory at the prestigious Miami Open. The win marked his firstever title win at the Miami Open. Medvedev clinched his fifth Masters 1000 title and 19th title overall by beating Sinner, who has also been in impressive form this season, with a scoreline of 7-5, 6-3.



Interestingly, Medvedev has won each of his 19 titles in different tournaments. This was also his first Masters 1000 title since winning in Toronto back in 2021.

By winning the Miami Open, Daniil Medvedev has also increased his advantage over Novak Djokovic in the ATP year-end rankings (Race to Turin) by 600 points. On the other hand, Jannik Sinner's performance in reaching the final has allowed him to climb to his career-best ranking of No. 9 in the men's singles chart.

Commonwealth champion weightlifter SanjitaChanu faces 4-year ban by NADA

- SanjitaChanu, a weightlifter from India who has won the Commonwealth Games twice, has been banned for four years by the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) of India after she tested positive for banned drugs. The testing took place during the National Games held in Gujarat in September-October 2022, and the results showed the presence of drostanolone, an anabolicandrogenic steroid prohibited by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).
- Drostanolone is mainly prescribed to treat advanced inoperable breast cancer in women, but it is commonly abused by athletes as a performance-enhancing drug. The primary medical purpose of drostanolone is to treat advanced inoperable breast cancer in women. Nevertheless, athletes often misuse the steroid as a performance-enhancing drug. Following her positive test for drostanolone, SanjitaChanu was temporarily suspended by NADA from the date of her sample collection, and her four-year suspension has now been formally declared. Consequently, Chanu will be stripped of her silver medal from the National Games as well.
- After testing positive for drostanolone, SanjitaChanu was provisionally suspended by NADA from the date of her sample collection, and her four-year ban has now been officially announced. As a result, Chanu will also lose her National Games silver medal. In the past year, several





Indian athletes who had qualified for the Tokyo Olympics, including Shivpal Singh, Kamalpreet Kaur, and DhanalakshmiSekar, along with Commonwealth Games bronze medalist Navjeet Kaur Dhillon and promising long jumper Aishwarya Babu, were found to have violated anti-doping regulations.

Bangladesh and Sri Lanka shared the third place in both men's and women's categories.

About the Asian Kho Kho Championships -

The 4th Asian Kho Kho Championships had a total of 16 teams, including both male and female teams, from various countries such as Bangladesh, Bhutan, Indonesia, Iran, Malaysia, Nepal, Singapore, South Korea, Sri Lanka, and host country India. The event was organized by the Kho Kho Federation of India and was hosted by the Assam Kho Kho Association with support from the BTR government and the government of Assam. Around 500 players and officials participated in the event, which was held on mats at the Tamulpur Higher Secondary School ground. The venue had a makeshift indoor stadium with a seating capacity of around 7,000 people. This was the first time the event was held in a semi-rural location, unlike the previous events which were held in urban areas such as Kolkata, Dhaka, and Indore. - Sri Lanka's attempt to move up to the eighth spot in the MRF Tyres ICC Men's Cricket World Cup Super League table has been unsuccessful, as they lost to New Zealand in the third ODI at Hamilton.

- will feature 10 teams. Seven teams have already secured their spots in the tournament, but Sri Lanka's loss means they remain outside of the top eight in the Super League standings and must continue to fight for qualification.
- The World Cup 2023 was set to feature the top 8 teams in the points table, but Sri Lanka's recent loss to New Zealand means they finished 9th in the standings. As a result, they must now compete in the ICC World Cup qualifiers, which will take place in Zimbabwe in June and July. The top two teams from the qualifiers will then qualify for the ICC ODI World Cup. This marks the first time in 44 years that the Sri Lankan team will have to play qualifiers in order to earn their place in the World Cup.
- Currently, there is a competition between West Indies and South Africa for the 8th position in the points table for the ICC Men's Cricket World Cup 2023. The West Indies team is currently holding the 8th position. The tournament will be hosted by India and will begin on October 5, 2023. The teams that have already qualified for the World Cup are New Zealand, England, India, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Australia, Afghanistan, and West Indies.

Sharjah stadium stand named after Sachin Tendulkar on his 50th birthday

In honor of Sachin Tendulkar's 50th birthday, the West Stand at the renowned Sharjah cricket stadium has been renamed as the 'Sachin Tendulkar Stand.' A special ceremony was held on Monday to commemorate the occasion, which coincided not only with the batting icon's birthday but also with the 25th anniversary of his remarkable performance of scoring back-to-back centuries against Australia in 1998, known as the 'Desert Storm,' in front of a packed stadium.







Sachin Tendulkar's outstanding performance in the final match of the Coca-Cola Cup, a triangular series between India, Australia, and New Zealand, held on April 22 and 24, 1998, is widely recognized as the 'Desert Storm'. He scored an impressive 143 and 134 in these two matches, which has been recorded in the history books. Tendulkar has scored a total of 49 centuries in One Day Internationals (ODIs) across 34 stadiums, but his exceptional performance at the Sharjah Cricket Stadium, where he scored the twin hundreds in April 1998, remains a memorable and celebrated achievement among his fans worldwide.

About the Sharjah Cricket Stadium -

- The Sharjah Cricket Stadium is a popular cricket stadium located in the emirate of Sharjah in the United Arab Emirates (UAE). It is one of the oldest cricket stadiums in the region, having been built in 1982. The stadium has a seating capacity of around 27,000 spectators and has hosted a large number of international cricket matches, including One Day Internationals (ODIs), Test matches, and Twenty 20 Internationals (T20Is).
- The stadium is well-known for its unique floodlights, which were installed in 1996 and were the first of their kind in the world. The stadium has also been awarded the Guinness World Record for hosting the most number of ODIs, with a total of 244 matches being played at the venue.

league of great Donald Bradman, Alan Davidson and Arthur Morris.






In 13 international matches at SCG, Mr. Tendulkar has scored 1,100 runs at an average of 100, with four centuries and four fifties and the best score of 241*. Behind West Indies' Viv Richards (1,134 runs) and Desmond Haynes (1,181 runs), he is the third-highest run-scorer at the venue among non-Australian players. In his 67 international matches there, Tendulkar scored 3,300 runs at an average of 42.85. He scored seven centuries and 17 half-centuries in the country, with the best score of 241*....






